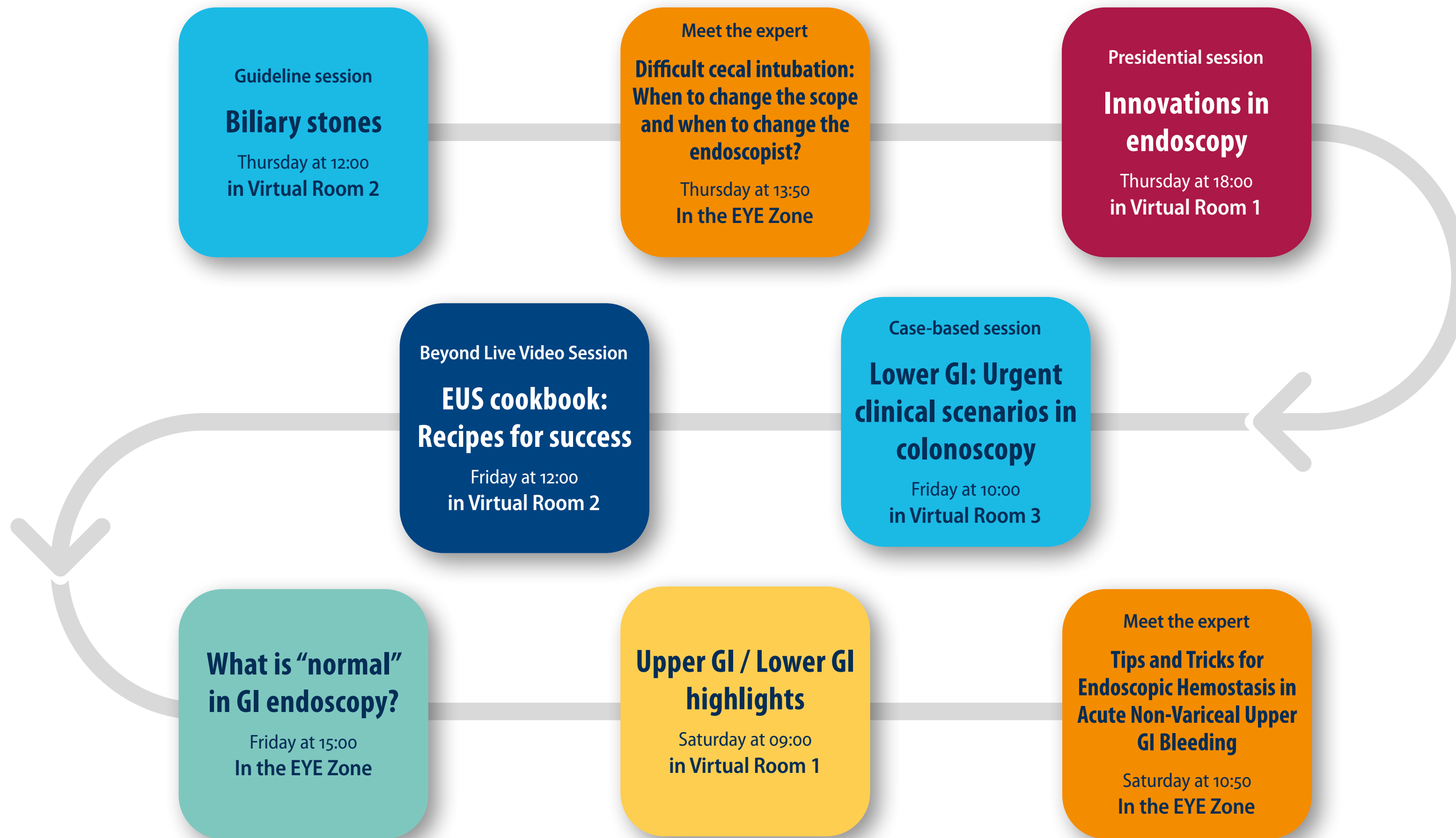


ESGE DAYS 2021 TRACK HIGHLIGHTS FOR YOUNG ENDOSCOPISTS
